

# 1. Download the mobile app

Download the Nokia Wi-Fi app to set up your Beacon 3.1, or follow the steps in this guide.



## 2. Plug in and power on

Plug in the power adapter and connect it to your Beacon 3.1.

Slide the power switch to turn it on.



# 3. Connect Ethernet

Plug the ethernet cable into the blue WAN port on your Beacon 3.1.



## 4. Connect modem

Connect the ethernet cable into designated internet service jack.



#### 5. Wait for the green light

The Beacon 3.1's internet lights will turn green when it is ready.



#### **Create account:**

- The app will now ask for your email address.
- After entering your email address, the app will send you an email verification.
- Open your email client and click the "Confirm your Email Address" button.
- Click "Verify Address" in the app.
- Using the app create a password.
- Follow the onscreen instuctions to proceed.

# 6. Place additional Beacons (if necessary)

Use the Nokia Wi-Fi app to set up and help to position additional Beacons.




# **Extend your wireless network**

You can also connect additional Beacons directly to the LAN port of the Beacon 3.1 and reposition them after they are all added to the wireless network.

#### 7. Connect to Wi-Fi

Connect your devices using the SSID and Wi-Fi Key shown on the bottom of the Beacon 3.1.



# Enjoy your Wi-Fi network

Your system may reboot after setup to optimize your network settings to your environment. This will take a couple of minutes and your network will be temporarily offline.
